### What do I do on day 1 of my placement and where do I go?

*Sydney Education* has commenced a new model of internal facilitation in partnership with education providers.

If your placement *is facilitated by Sydney Education staff*, you will be required to meet the facilitation team in the foyer of the respective hospital or clinic, at 0800 on day 1.

If your *education provider is facilitating the placement*, please proceed directly to the unit you are assigned to on day 1.

If you are unsure who is to facilitate your placement, check in with your education provider.

### Nursing Placement Model utilised by Balmain Hospital:

The *Director of Nursing at Balmain Hospital* has approved an innovative clinical placement model, which allows students to be moved around Balmain Hospital whilst attending placement, to allow the student to be exposed to aged care, in its fullest capacity. Some students may not get everything required out of the ward they are allocated to, simply because of the case mix within the unit, e.g. students allocated to the transitional care unit may not be able to meet their assigned clinical objectives, which could be met if they were assigned to Wakefield ward. This existing opportunity is available to everyone.

### Start Times:

All start times at Balmain Hospital for AM shifts commence at 0800 on day 1 and 0700 on subsequent days *except for the GP Clinic*, which from day 2 commences at 0730.

All PM shifts commence at 1330.

### eLearning Modules:

*Access to My Health Learning will open 13 days prior to your placement commencing.*

*Instructions regarding how to log-in to complete all eLearning modules (including eMR training) will be mailed to the email address noted in your ClinConnect profile, which is established by your education provider.*

All students are required to complete several eLearning modules prior to commencement. Please note that two of these modules are required to be completed annually by all NSW Health staff and students, enrolled in Health-Related courses.

### **eMR Requirements:**

All students must complete the eMR module accessed through My Health Learning and submit their eMR application to their education provider **no later than 10 days prior to placement commencing**. The education provider will submit eMR applications and proof that the eMR module has been completed, to the SLHD Clinical Placement Unit.

Applications will then be submitted to the eMR team to process; the eMR team will review and establish access to the eMR and return log-in details to the education provider, for distribution to students. **Students will NOT be able to function in the clinical environment without access to the eMR.** Once eMR access has been established, and if you have any issues relating to password re-sets or general access issues, **please contact your education provider for assistance and advice - DO NOT call the Statewide Help Desk or approach IT services or local staff to assist to gain access to the eMR.**

### **Influenza and COVID Vaccination Requirements:**

The annual influenza vaccination is mandatory for all placements that occur between 1 June and 30 September, unless you are assigned to a Commonwealth funded Aged Care Facility, where it is required for the whole year. The *Australian Immunisation Handbook* recommends that all Australians stay up to date with their COVID vaccination boosters and this is especially recommended for students entering a health-related profession.
