



## Terms and Conditions

### Rules

- Entrants must be residents of the state of NSW.
- Each entry must only include original material created by the person named as the entrant.
- Each entrant can submit a maximum of 3 photographs.
- The entrant grants SLHD publishing permission to reproduce the photograph(s) on the intranet, internet (e.g. social media, website, etc.), promotional materials and other publications without any usage restrictions.
- The entrant may opt-in during registration to sell framed copies of his/her photograph(s) to interested buyer(s). If such occasion arises, SLHD (Mental Health) will facilitate the process for free. The recommended default pricing is \$50 but you may nominate a higher price if you wish. The buyer will be charged the default price (or your price) plus the framing and delivery costs for each photograph purchased. For example:  
Photographer's price: \$50  
Framing cost: \$40  
Delivery cost: \$10  
Total cost to buyer: \$100
- The photograph(s) must have been created in the last 12 months.
- The photograph(s) must have not been submitted to any other competition prior to this competition.
- The entrant must be the creator of the photograph(s).
- The entrant must own the copyright of the photograph(s).
- Copyright of the photograph(s) remains with the photographer.
- The entrant indemnifies SLHD against any claim, legal or otherwise, that may arise out of the publication of the photograph(s).
- A Release of Photographic Subject form must be signed by any identifiable person appearing in your photograph(s). For persons under the age of 18 years this must include the signature of their parent or guardian.
- You may not take photographs that could identify any current patient within a Sydney Local Health District mental health facility. Non-identifiable photographs are acceptable. Permission to photograph within a Unit is at the discretion of the Unit Manager and must not cause distress to others.
- Artistic expression is encouraged but entrants should not submit photograph(s) that may infringe upon the rights of others, be defamatory or be in violation of the law.
- An entry must not infringe upon the copyright, trademark or any other intellectual property rights of any third party or violate any person's rights to privacy and confidentiality.
- Entries will be accepted up until midnight of Friday, 30th September 2022.



- By entering photographs into this competition the entrant guarantees to SLHD that the above entry requirements have been met and these terms and conditions are accepted.
- Submission of photographs into this competition does not guarantee the photographs will be displayed or exhibited.

## Photograph Specifications

It is recommended that photographs be in the form of a jpg/jpeg file and at least 5 megapixels. For other formats or sizes please check with the Competition Coordinator.

Entrants are also required to submit a title for each of their photographs and a description of between 25 -100 words. Judging is made by considering both the photograph and the description.

## Judging

Only entries compliant with the terms and conditions of the competition will be considered eligible for the competition.

Photographs will be judged on technical excellence, composition and artistic merit. Judging will be conducted by a panel constituted by SLHD employees and/or guest judges, to be selected by the Mental Health Service at its sole discretion. There will be no fewer than 3 judges.

Scores will be given out of 10, averaged and multiplied by 10 to give a final score out of 100 for each photograph.

In the event of a tie, the entries which have tied will be re-submitted to the Judges for a second consideration and a final judgement.

All decisions (including scores) of the judges are final and will be binding on each entrant. No correspondence will be entered into.

## Rights and Usage of Photographs

Each entrant retains all copyright to their photographs and SLHD asserts no claims or rights for commercial purpose to any photographs entered into the Competition except as expressly set out in these Terms and Conditions. SLHD will only use entries in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or as otherwise specifically agreed between SLHD and individual entrants.

Prize winning entries/awardees and any such other entries determined by SLHD, will be displayed in the physical and/or online Competition Exhibition.

Prize winning entries/awardees and any such other entries determined by SLHD may be published on the intranet, internet and other publications such as a flyer, booklet or book and promotional materials.

By submitting an entry, each entrant grants SLHD:

- A non-exclusive and irrevocable licence to exercise all rights over their entry, including without limitation, the right to reproduce and communicate the entry to the public in whole or in part, in perpetuity in any media.

Each entrant agrees that their entry or entries may be edited or adapted at any time by the SLHD for legal, editorial or operational reasons. Submission of photographs into this competition does not guarantee those photographs will be displayed or exhibited.
