
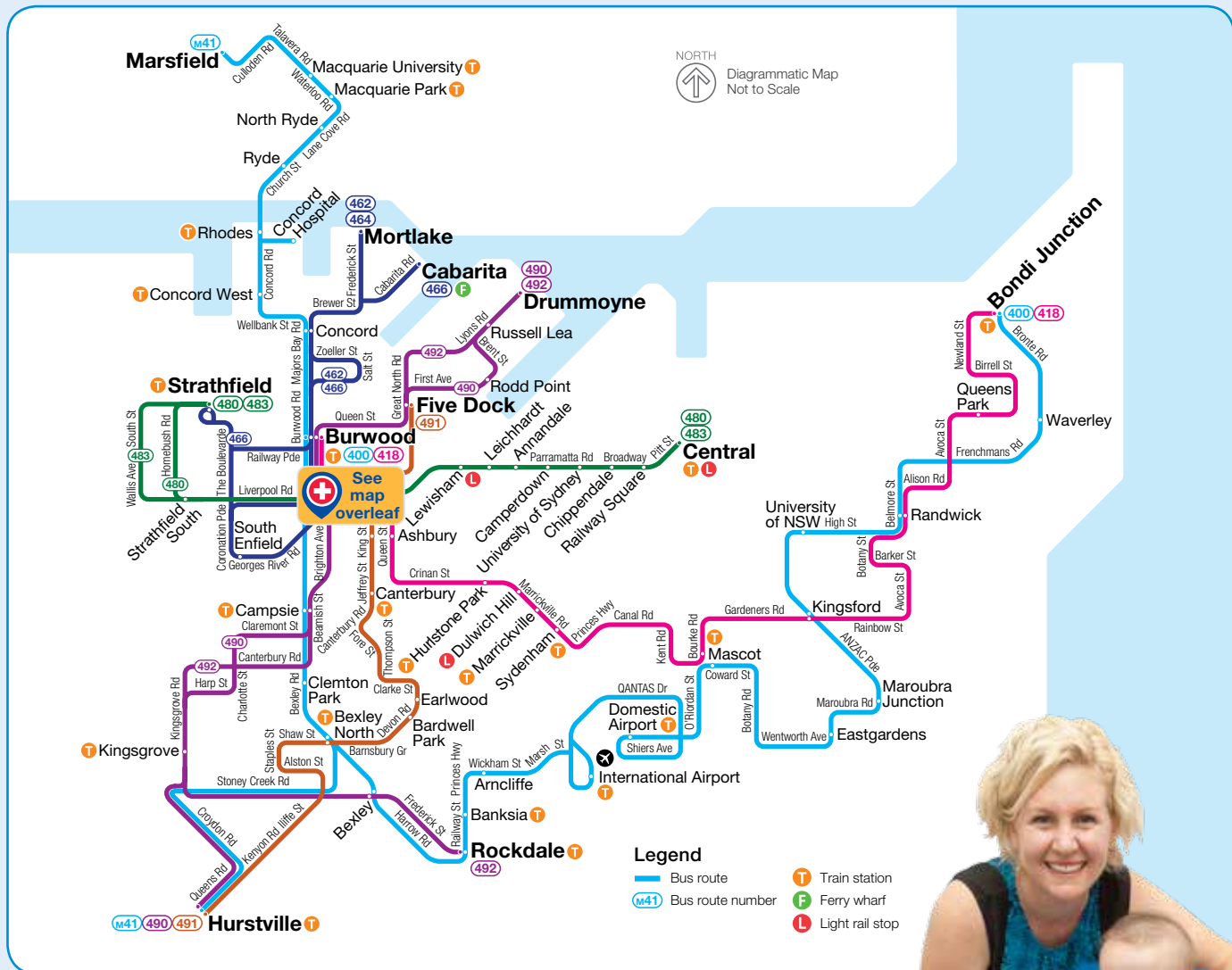

Walking

Cycling
 There are no bicycle parking facilities at the Centre. Suggested cycling routes are shown on the map.



Bus
 Routes 418, 480, 483, 490 and 492 are available on Liverpool Rd. Additional services are available nearby.

Train

Taxi

Parking
 Free underground on-site parking is available via the entrance off Croydon Ave, including three disabled spots.

 Access Sydney Community Transport provides transport to medical appointments for those who are living independently but are transport disadvantaged.

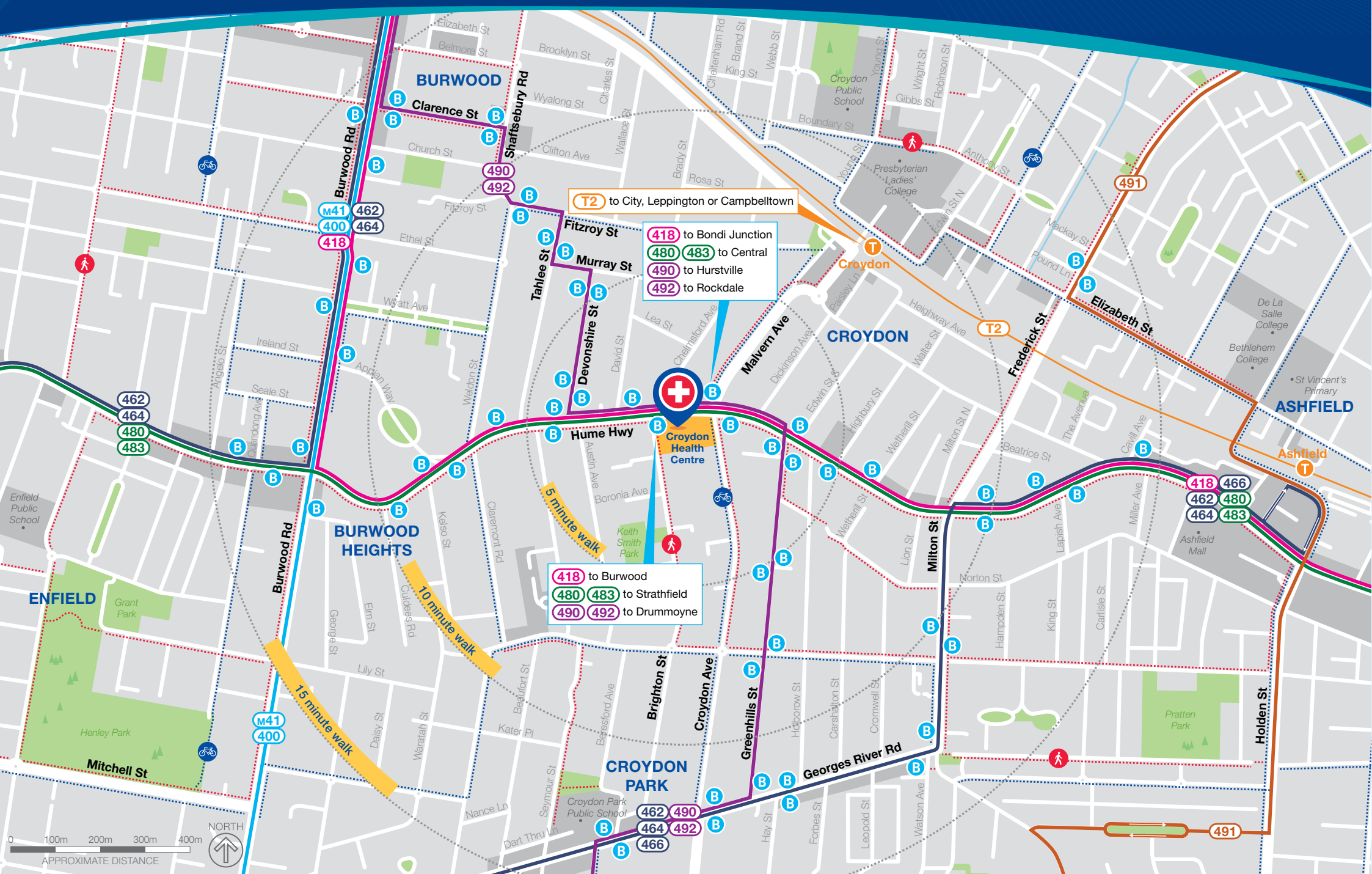
