Brief description of service/department	<p>Canterbury Community Oral Health Clinic provides a range of services to eligible patients which include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Restorations (fillings)</li> <li>- Extractions through local anaesthetic</li> <li>- Preventative advice and treatment (e.g. dental cleans).</li> <li>- Root canal therapy</li> <li>- Denture services</li> <li>- Oral health education and promotion</li> </ul> <p>Periodontal (gum) treatments</p>
Important information for Patient/How to prepare for your visit to our department	<p>To be eligible for this service you must fit the description for eligibility which includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Children and young people less than 18 years old and are able to have Medicare.</li> <li>- Adults aged 18 years or older who have or listed as the following:</li> <li>- Health care card; or</li> <li>- Pensioner concession card; or</li> <li>- Commonwealth senior's health card.</li> </ul> <p>If it is your first time here at the oral health clinic, make sure you bring the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A current Medicare card</li> <li>- A current Pension or Health care card</li> <li>- Photographic ID (e.g. drivers licence or passport)</li> <li>- Details of any medication that you are taking</li> </ul> <p>Proof of residency (e.g. driver's licence, bill)</p>
