Brief description of service/department	<p>This telephone service provides dental appointments for eligible patients who have a medicare card and pension card .</p> <p>If you have an acute dental problem, you will be offered the next available appointment at any clinic across Sydney and South West Sydney Local Health Districts and Northern Sector of South Eastern Sydney, depending on the information given and how easy it is for you to get to the clinic.</p> <p>For booked appointments, a letter is sent to you confirming the date, time and place where you will need to attend. A medical history questionnaire will also be sent for you to complete.</p>
Important information for Patient/How to prepare for your visit to our department	<p>On the day of your appointment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrive 15 minutes before the appointment time, • Bring Centrelink cards, Medicare card & Photo Id card). • A list of what medicines you take • A completed medical history questionnaire (if you have problems completing it, staff will help you with this)
