Important information for Patient/How to prepare for your visit to our department	<p>To be eligible for this service you must fit the description for eligibility which includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Children and young people less than 18 years old and are able to have Medicare. - Adults aged 18 years or older who have or listed as the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Health care card; or - Pensioner concession card; or - Commonwealth senior's health card. <p>If it is your first time here at the oral health clinic, make sure you bring the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A current Medicare card - A current Pension or Health care card - Photographic ID (e.g. drivers licence or passport) - Details of any medication that you are taking - Proof of residency (e.g. driver's licence, bill)
