What is it? Advice for clinicians preparing ethics applications or responding to an HREC letter. Advice on updates in REGIS. Do I need to book? Yes - if you would like to discuss your project you will need to contact us to book a time. If you arrive by 1pm, it will stay open until 2pm or until everyone is seen.

What to bring? This depends on where you are at in preparing your initial ethics application or a response. Bring relevant documents if you have them, such as your draft protocol, draft ethics application form etc.

Will I be required to do anything? You will be invited to provide voluntary, anonymous feedback on the clinic.
