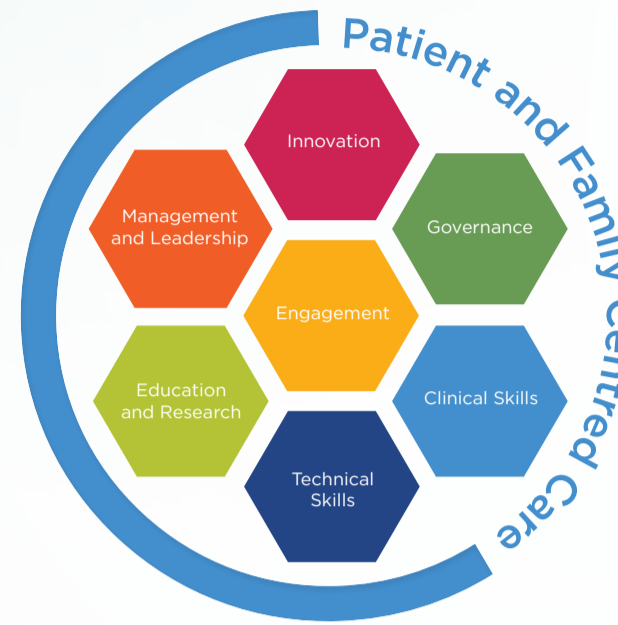


Face-to-face Education
