Why Should I Enrol?

This program provides participants with both the theoretical and practical skills to enhance their development as frontline clinical educators. Through participation in sessions you will be supported to carry out a workplace educational needs analysis and to develop practical strategies for your team. This program will also be a great opportunity to network with fellow clinical educators and to share ideas and initiatives.

Target Audience

People employed in either a permanent or acting Clinical Nurse Educator or Clinical Midwifery Educator role.

Participant Requirements

Participation in four workshops delivered over a four month period at the CEWD Rozelle campus. Participants will also be required to conduct a workplace project that will be presented to members of the Nursing and Midwifery Executive at the conclusion of the program.

Prerequisites for Application

Current employment as a CNE/CME in SLHD.

Support Provided to Participants

Application Process
