## Graduate Certificate in Health Research

### Why should I enrol?

This new qualification provides a great opportunity for participants to gain knowledge, skills and experience in undertaking a research project in the workplace. The knowledge, skills and experience they obtain will assist them to critically analyse research findings and consider how their own research and the published research of others should be best applied to healthcare services. This will equip them to make a positive impact on the research culture of their organisation.

### Target Audience

Sydney Local Health District staff members who seek to apply knowledge, practical skills and experience in conducting their own research and applying the results of their own and others' research across a range of clinical and non-clinical roles in the healthcare system.

### Participant Requirements

Participants should be familiar with basic internet searching and Excel so that resources discussed in the workshop can be understood. An introductory understanding of statistics and research design is not required.

Enrolment is only open to District staff members who are not currently enrolled in (and have not previously completed) a research Masters or PhD.

### Support Provided to Participants

Participants will be provided with a mixture of online and face-to-face delivery of course content, independent learning activities, resources for basic statistical calculations, and mentoring to conduct a research project.
