All health workers have a role to play in identifying and supporting children and young people who are vulnerable to abuse and neglect, and their families.

New, online training is now available to support health workers to:

- Be curious about children and young people's safety and wellbeing.
- Actively respond before risks escalate.
- Respectfully engage with families.
- Know how the NSW Health Child Wellbeing Unit can assist on 1300 480 420.
- Report to the Child Protection Helpline on 132 111 or e Report.
- Respond to survivors of historical abuse.
- Seek advice and support - you are not expected to respond alone.
