

## ICT Services: Rollout of Google Chrome Browser

Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2018

Dear all,

To provide a better experience when you use Recruitment and On-boarding (ROB) at SLHD, ICT Services are gradually installing the Google Chrome browser on every SLHD workstation from 21<sup>st</sup> Feb to 27<sup>th</sup> Feb 2018. It is then recommended that when using My Health Learning, you do so through Google Chrome.

### What will happen? –and what do I need to do?

This installation will take place automatically over the network to workstations that are turned on and you are not required to do anything to make this happen. We expect that the installation will have completed on most computers by 11:00am Tuesday 27th February 2018.

### How will I know if I have Google Chrome installed?

You have the browser installed on your workstation if you have the Google Chrome icon on your desktop (pictured to the right).

Click on the browser and navigate to My Health Learning in the same way you have done in Internet Explorer.

### What if I don't have it by the completion time listed (27<sup>th</sup> Feb)?

In the event that you do not receive the Chrome browser, please call the ICT Service Desk on **9515 8877** for assistance. ICT services will install the Chrome browser for you manually.
