DIAGNOSIS: CARCINOMA OF MALE BREAST.

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/80. A lump which increased fairly rapidly in size appeared in the breast of this elderly man who had been treated with stilboestrol for carcinoma of the prostate. Mastectomy was performed.

MACROSCOPIC: The breast has been bisected to show that its enlargement is due to a pale tumour 7cm in maximum diameter. Normal adipose tissue remains at either pole.

MICROSCOPIC: In some areas this infiltrating ductal carcinoma has prominent fibrous stroma (left), whilst in other areas, the tumour is more cellular with some gland formation (right). Metastases were present in the axillary lymph nodes.
