DIAGNOSIS: ANEURYSM OF BRACHIAL ARTERY.

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/44. The patient presented with numbness in the index and middle fingers of the left hand, which were cold and blue on examination. A lump was felt in the left cubital fossa. An aneurysm of the left brachial artery was excised and replaced with a vein graft.

MACROSCOPIC: The segment of artery shows aneurysmal dilatation and the lumen is filled with thrombus.

MICROSCOPIC: The section shows laminated organising thrombus.
