DIAGNOSIS: ADRENAL CORTICAL ADENOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/69. The patient had Cushingoid features (obesity, hypertension and diabetes) for 10 years, with recent muscle weakness, dry skin, hirsutism, and hoarse voice. A left adrenal tumour weighing 117 grams was removed.

MACROSCOPIC: The specimen consists of a bisected, well circumscribed tumour mass 70x60x53mm. The cut surface has a pale creamy appearance with some yellowish areas and an area of haemorrhage and cystic change.

MICROSCOPIC: The tumour cells are arranged in nests and have abundant clear cytoplasm (containing lipid) with fairly uniform round nuclei.
