**DIAGNOSIS:** THYROID - PAPILLARY CARCINOMA

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/75 A lump in the right side of the neck had been present and gradually increasing in size for two months. At a surgical operation, the right lobe of the thyroid was found to contain tumour. Hemithyroidectomy was performed together with unilateral block dissection of gland of the neck. No further history is available.

**MACROSCOPIC:** The thyroid lobe has been bisected and shows a variegated solid nodule, partly haemorrhagic and in most part apparently well demarcated from the surrounding gland. The opaque, chalky areas represent foci of calcification.

**MICROSCOPIC:** The nodule is a carcinoma of cuboidal cell type with a very characteristic papillary pattern. No metastases were found in the lymph nodes.
