DIAGNOSIS: LEIOMYOSARCOMA OF UTERUS.

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/70. Diagnostic uterine curettage was performed because of post-menopausal bleeding and a histological diagnosis of poorly differentiated spindle cell sarcoma was made. Hysterectomy was performed, and at the same time, some peritoneal metastases were noted. Pulmonary and bony metastases developed six months later and she died eighteen months after her operation.

MACROSCOPIC: There is an oval, yellowish neoplasm filling the lumen of the uterus and replacing the anterior myometrial wall. The bisected nodule on the right represents a peritoneal metastasis.

MICROSCOPIC: The tumour is made up of spindle cells with rather plump, somewhat pleomorphic, nuclei. Myofibrils could be demonstrated with special stains and there was extensive necrosis.
