DIAGNOSIS: CARCINOMA OF ENDOMETRIUM

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/63. The patient complained of bleeding PV for “a number of years” but it had become more severe “in recent weeks”. She was found to have a moderate hypochromic anaemia and vaginal hysterectomy was performed. No follow up is available.

MACROSCOPIC: The upper half of the endometrial cavity is filled by a craggy, pale neoplasm. The rest of the endometrium is normal.

MICROSCOPIC: The neoplasm is seen to be a well differentiated columnar cell adenocarcinoma. Pleomorphism is minimal and a moderate number of mitotic figures are present.
