DIAGNOSIS: FALLOPIAN TUBE - ECTOPIC PREGNANCY

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/35. The patient was seven weeks pregnant when she suffered sudden severe pain in the left iliac fossa. A left tubal ectopic pregnancy was removed laparoscopically and uterine curettage was also performed.

MACROSCOPIC: This segment of fallopian tube is distended with blood clot which is surrounding some pale translucent membranous material.

MICROSCOPIC: The section of the fallopian tube shows the thin wall below, with blood clot and chorionic villi in the lumen (left image). The section of the uterine curettings shows decidua and hypersecretory gestational type endometrium, consistent with pregnancy (right image).
