DIAGNOSIS: OVARY - MUCINOUS CYSTADENOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/65. A large pelvic mass was found, following the complaint of vague lower abdominal pain. The lesion was removed surgically and the patient was known to be alive fourteen years later.

MACROSCOPIC: The ovary has been replaced by a large translucent mass made up of many thin-walled cysts. These contained a thin glairy fluid. Blood vessels running between the cysts are prominent.

MICROSCOPIC: Where it still survives, the cysts are lined by a layer of uniform tall mucin secreting columnar cells.
