DIAGNOSIS: OVARY – MALIGNANT GRANULAR CELL TUMOUR

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/63. Following a two day history of lower abdominal discomfort and distension, a large mass was found which arose from the pelvis. Laparotomy was performed and this large ovarian tumour was removed. It was haemorrhagic and thought to have undergone torsion.

MACROSCOPIC: This encapsulated tumour consists of lobules of buff coloured tissue. There has also been extensive bleeding in some places and the pale areas on the reverse represent necrosis.

MICROSCOPIC: The tumour is made up of closely packed polygonal cells, which in some places are becoming somewhat regimented, forming a vague trabecular pattern.
