DIAGNOSIS: ADENOLYMPHOMA OF PAROTID GLAND.

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/62. This man presented with a four month history of bilateral parotid swellings slowly increasing in size. Surgical removal of the lump on the right side was undertaken and two weeks later that on the left was extirpated. Their histology was similar.

MACROSCOPIC: A greyish well circumscribed tumour has been bisected. A vague closely packed papillary structure can be seen especially on the left. Bilateral tumours of this kind are unusual.

MICROSCOPIC: Irregular spaces are lined by epithelium two cells thick typical of salivary ducts. Lymphocytes are packed into the interstitial tissue.
