DIAGNOSIS: FOCAL NODULAR HYPERPLASIA OF LIVER

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/41. Vague abdominal pain, solitary solid lesion (4cm in diameter) in right lobe of liver removed by sigmental resection. No drugs.

MACROSCOPIC: Specimen consists of a wedge of liver in which there is a circumscribed nodule projecting slightly on the capsular surface. The cut surface of the nodule shows brownish-yellow tissue with a central stellate scar.

MICROSCOPIC: Section of the nodule shows hyperplastic liver cells with intervening fibrous septa in which there is proliferation of bile ducts with a mild chronic inflammatory cell infiltrate. The rest of the liver shows normal architecture.
