**DIAGNOSIS:** GALL BLADDER – CHOLESTEROL STONES, CHRONIC CHOLECYSTITIS

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/74. No history is available.

**MACROSCOPIC:** A thick walled distended gall bladder contains three typical bosselated roughly oval cholesterol stones. Cross section of a stone lodged in the neck of the gall bladder shows a central core of darker material.

**MICROSCOPIC:** The muscularis has been replaced by dense fibrous tissue in which there are scattered collections of lymphocytes. The epithelium has been destroyed by previous inflammatory episodes.
