DIAGNOSIS: GALL BLADDER – ADENOSQUAMOUS CARCINOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/82. The patient had a two week history of increasing pain in the right iliac fossa, with tenderness in the right upper and lower quadrants. Ultrasound and CT scan showed numerous calculi with thickening of the gall bladder wall.

MACROSCOPIC: The specimen shows a pale tumour 40mm in maximum dimension, arising from the body of the gall bladder. The tumour extends into adjacent liver tissue.

MICROSCOPIC: Sections show a poorly differentiated large cell carcinoma, with areas of gland formation (left image) and areas of squamous differentiation (right image), supporting a diagnosis of adenosquamous carcinoma.
