DIAGNOSIS: PANCREAS – MICROCYSTIC SEROUS CYSTADENOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/92. CT investigation of right loin pain showed a cystic mass in the tail of pancreas. Distal pancreatectomy was performed.

MACROSCOPIC: The specimen consists of portion of tumour, the cut surface of which shows a multiloculated cystic appearance. The cysts are predominantly small, separated by thin fibrous septae. The blue material around the tumour was applied by the pathologist to assist in identifying the lines of resection of the specimen.

MICROSCOPIC: Section shows numerous cysts of varying size and shaped, lined by flattened to cuboidal cells with clear cytoplasm. The predominant small size of the cysts is consistent with the microcystic variant of a serous cystadenoma of the pancreas.
