DIAGNOSIS: SMALL BOWEL – METASTATIC TUMOUR & INTUSSUSCEPTION

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/67. The patient was known to have large cell carcinoma of the lung with metastases. He presented with vomiting and melaena one week before his death.

MACROSCOPIC: The specimen consists of a segment of small bowel in which there is an intussusception. The distal portion of the jejunum has been opened to show a necrotic tumour mass at the head of the intussusception.

MICROSCOPIC: The section of the tumour mass shows sheets of large malignant cells, similar in appearance to the previously diagnosed large cell carcinoma of the lung.
