DIAGNOSIS: SMALL BOWEL – EOSINOPHILIC ENTERITIS

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/71. Presented with vague symptoms and some weight loss. A firm mass was felt PR which at laparotomy involved portion of the ileum and sigmoid colon and was adherent to the bladder, left fallopian tube and ovary.

MACROSCOPIC: Specimen consists of a portion of small intestine with a thickened markedly indurated wall giving a cobblestone appearance with mucosal ulceration. Portions of fallopian tube and ovary are adherent to the serosal surface.

MICROSCOPIC: There is a dense inflammatory infiltrate including numerous eosinophils throughout the wall of the small bowel.
