**ID NOS:** 172820

**DIAGNOSIS:** DUODENUM – SUBMUCOSAL LIPOMA.

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** F/age unknown. The patient presented with recurrent melaena. Endoscopy revealed a large polyp in the third part of the duodenum, which was surgically removed.

**MACROSCOPIC:** Specimen consists of a sausage shaped lesion covered by mucosa measuring 65x20x17mm. The cut surface shows yellow fatty tissue.

**MICROSCOPIC:** Sections show a submucosal lipoma consisting of mature adipose tissue. There is focal ulceration of the overlying mucosa with associated inflammation (right image).
