**DIAGNOSIS:** CHRONIC DUODENAL ULCER WITH HAEMORRHAGE.

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/72. There was a long history of hypertension and duodenal ulcer. After admission for urinary tract infection, the patient collapsed with hypotension and melaena and died.

**MACROSCOPIC:** Specimen consists of portion of stomach and duodenum. There is a large ulcer in the first part of the duodenum on the posterior wall. Portion of pancreas is attached posteriorly and probably forms part of the base of the ulcer. The ulcer has a punched out appearance with rolled edges and a shaggy base with some adherent blood clot. A large eroded vessel is present in the base of the ulcer.
