DIAGNOSIS: COLON - FAMILIAL POLYPOSIS COLI

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/60. A prophylactic subtotal colectomy was carried out for familial polyposis. Both parents died of carcinoma of the bowel. His four brothers and two sisters are all well.

MACROSCOPIC: The specimen consists of the terminal ileum, the appendix and the large bowel to the level of the lower sigmoid colon. Scattered throughout the length of the colon, but more numerous in the descending portion, there are many rounded or elongated polyps, the largest about 1cm in diameter.

MICROSCOPIC: Sections of the polyps show low grade dysplasia with no evidence of malignancy.
