DIAGNOSIS: RECTUM – TUBULOVILLOUS ADENOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/62. The patient had a rectal polyp which was associated with bleeding. It finally prolapsed and was excised.

MACROSCOPIC: The specimen is a cauliflower like polyp with a coarse nodular surface. At the back can be seen the line of resection through normal mucosa (right image).

MICROSCOPIC: The tumour is a tubulo-villous adenoma with low grade dysplasia. There is no evidence of high grade dysplasia or invasion.
