**DIAGNOSIS:** HYPOSPADIAS AND UNDESCENDED TESTIS

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/64. The patient was known to have abnormal genitalia, as well as dementia, Korsakoff's psychosis, Barrett's oesophagus, and chronic obstructive airways disease. He presented with shortness of breath and died soon after. At autopsy he was found to have a lung cancer and a small cerebral infarcton.

**MACROSCOPIC:** The specimen of the genitalia shows the under developed penis (hypospadias). A small testis is present in the left inguinal region. The right testis was removed from the right inguinal region for microscopic examination.

**MICROSCOPIC:** Sections of the testis show a fibrous capsule (left image) with hyalinised tubules with no spermatogenesis. No Leydig cells are seen.
