DIAGNOSIS: MALAKOPLAKIA OF TESTIS

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/75. Increase in size of left testis.

MACROSCOPIC: Specimen consists of a bisected testis; the normal appearance of which has been replaced by firm homogeneous creamy tissue (malakoplakia or soft plaque) which appears slightly lobulated.

MICROSCOPIC: The normal architecture of the testis is replaced by a cellular proliferation consisting predominantly of histiocytes with occasional plasma cells and lymphocytes. Numerous concentrically laminated Michaelis-Gutmann bodies are seen in this section stained with PAS, and represent incompletely digested bacilli. Malakoplakia is a complication of chronic infection.
