DIAGNOSIS: TORSION OF TESTIS WITH ATROPHY

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/20. This young man gave a history of pain in the right testis brought on by sexual intercourse and other exertion. Past history suggested an episode of torsion in the same testis a year previously. A testis the size of an olive stone was removed.

MACROSCOPIC: Cross-section of this tiny testis shows none of the characteristics of the normal organ except that it has a thick fibrous tunica. The normal buff coloured seminiferous tubules have been replaced by brownish homogeneous material.

MICROSCOPIC: Outlines of necrotic seminiferous tubules are still recognisable with some organisation beneath the fibrous tunica.
