DIAGNOSIS: TESTIS – MALIGNANT TERATOMA.

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/50. The patient discovered a hard nodule in the body of one testis adjacent to the epididymis, and an orchidectomy was performed.

MACROSCOPIC: The bisected testis shows most of the seminiferous tubules have been replaced by an apparently well demarcated neoplasm, which has a number of small cysts and haemorrhages.

MICROSCOPIC: The tumour has a variegated appearance with focal haemorrhage, necrosis, cystic change and areas of glandular formation (left image). Most of the tumour consists of anaplastic malignant cells (right image).
