DIAGNOSIS: TESTIS – MALIGNANT LYMPHOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/70. The patient had a history of an enlarging right testis over a few months, and the testis was removed together with the epididymis and spermatic cord. The pathology showed an undifferentiated tumour. He was then found to have generalised lymphadenopathy and a biopsy of a cervical lymph node showed a malignant lymphoma. His general condition deteriorated and he died 3 months after the initial admission.

MACROSCOPIC: The testis is markedly enlarged by tan tumour tissue. The spermatic is thickened and involved by tumour. An encapsulated epididymal cyst 20mm in length with dark contents is present above the testis.

MICROSCOPIC: The tumour infiltrates between and into the seminiferous tubules (left image) and is composed of mostly large atypical lymphoid cells (right image).
