DIAGNOSIS: LARGE CELL LYMPHOMA INVOLVING TESTIS.

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/67, The patient had a history of a painful swollen testis for four weeks which had increased rapidly in size for the last week. An orchidectomy was performed followed by chemotherapy. The patient died five months later. An autopsy showed widespread lymphoma, particularly involving the thoracic and abdominal lymph nodes.

MACROSCOPIC: The body of the testis is enlarged and the upper for fifths of the cut surface shoes infiltration by pale structureless neoplastic tissue.

MICROSCOPIC: There is extensive tumour necrosis (left image). The viable lymphoma cells are large with vesicular nuclei (right image). A residual epididymal gland is present.
