DIAGNOSIS: HAEMATOCELE OF TESTIS

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/81. For 23 years this patient had had a hydrocoele tapped every six months. He had suffered pain in the right side of his scrotum for five weeks, and an orchidectomy was performed,

MACROSCOPIC: To the left of the yellow body of the testis, there is a cavity about 40x20mm partly filled with old blood clot paler in the centre than at the periphery. The vascular spermatic cord can be seen above; the epididymis is not included in the plane of section. The lesion represents old haemorrhage into the tunica vaginalis.

MICROSCOPIC: The thick fibrous tunica is covered by blood clot showing organisation. Plump fibroblasts are migrating into the clot accompanied by newly formed capillaries.
