DIAGNOSIS: HAEMATOCOELE OF TESTIS

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/25. There was a history of trauma to testis nine months previously with subsequent swelling.

MACROSCOPIC: Specimen consists of a portion of testis with a thickened capsule. At one side there is a large cavity which has formed within the layers of the tunica vaginalis. The cavity contains remnants of friable haemorrhagic tissue adherent to the wall. The testis appears compressed and elongated but the cut surface appears normal.

MACROSCOPIC: Sections show testicular tissue with reduction in spermatogenesis, a thick collagenous fibrous tissue wall, and some adherent blood clot.
