**DIAGNOSIS:** LIPOMA OF SPERMATIC CORD

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/71. The patient has a mass above the left testis for at least two years. Orchidectomy with removal of the adjacent lump was performed.

**MACROSCOPIC:** The specimen consists of testis, epididymis and spermatic cord. An oval mass of adipose tissue is situated in the cord immediately above the testis. The central portion shows grey myxomatous degenerative changes. A smaller nodule of adipose tissue (measuring 30x10mm) is present at the upper end of the cord.

**MICROSCOPIC:** Much of the actual fat has been replaced by myxomatous degeneration. There is also a scattering of mixed inflammatory cells.
