DIAGNOSIS: BRAIN - CAVERNOUS HAEMANGIOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/57. This patient was said to be mentally subnormal and to suffer from chronic schizophrenia. Any relationship between the lesion displayed and his clinical state is doubtful. Death resulted from coronary artery disease.

MACROSCOPIC: Embedded immediately beneath the surface of the parietal lobe is a brown, well-delineated lesion about 1.5cm in diameter. An unusually prominent meningeal vessel is seen to be closely associated with it.

MICROSCOPIC: Thin-walled vascular spaces of irregular shape and size are typical of a cavernous haemangioma.
