**DIAGNOSIS:** CEREBRAL HAEMORRHAGE

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/70. The patient was known to be hypertensive. Sudden onset of frontal headache, nausea and vomiting with right sided weakness. CT scan showed left parietal-occipital haemorrhage which was drained through a burr hole. However, the patient's condition deteriorated and he died.

**MACROSCOPIC:** The specimen consists of a portion of the left parietal lobe in which there is a large haematoma occupying the central white matter. Blood clot extends onto the surface of the brain at the site of the burr hole.

**MICROSCOPIC:** No photomicrographs.
