DIAGNOSIS: BRONCHUS - LARGE CELL CARCINOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/66. The patient was a heavy smoker and suffered from increasing dyspnoea, with anorexia and weight loss for one year. A chest X-ray showed a cavitating left hilar mass.

MACROSCOPIC: The specimen consists of the upper lobe of the left lung in which there is a haemorrhagic tumour mass in the hilar region, surrounding the left main bronchus and the pulmonary artery.

MICROSCOPIC: The section shows an undifferentiated large cell carcinoma.
