DIAGNOSIS: LUNG – ASPERGILLOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/68. The patient had pulmonary emphysema, and a chest Xray revealed a mass in the upper lobe of the right lung, which was excised.

MACROSCOPIC: This portion of lung tissue contains a compressed cavity (which originally measured 30x30x20mm), with an irregular rough lining.

MICROSCOPIC: Sections show organising thrombus with blood clot and masses of fungal hyphae in the cavity (left image). The fungi are septate and branching and are more readily seen with a methenamine silver stain (right image). The features are those of an Aspergilloma.
