DIAGNOSIS: LUNG - FIBROCASEOUS TUBERCULOSIS

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/24. This young man presented to hospital with an anal fistula. A chest Xray showed a pulmonary mass and sputum examination showed acid fast bacilli. A biopsy of the anal fistula showed that it also was tuberculous.

MACROSCOPIC: This specimen of lower lobe shows a well demarcated pale caseous lesion. There are a number of small pale tubercles scattered through the rest of the lung tissue.

MICROSCOPIC: The section shows pink caseous necrosis on the left. There are a few multinucleated giant cells around the edge of the lesion.
