

DIAGNOSIS: LUNGS – TUBERCULOSIS

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/60. The patient received specific treatment for pulmonary tuberculosis for many years. His final admission was due to repeated haemoptysis. He died a few days later from massive haemorrhage.

MACROSCOPIC: The right lung (19A) is greatly shrunken. It shows typical fibro caseous tuberculosis with cavitation at the apex and generalises spread of the disease elsewhere. The bronchial mucosa is thickened, ulcerated and inflamed. The left lung (19B) shows tuberculous broncho pneumonia, especially in the lower half. The larger pale areas are foci of caseation.

MICROSCOPIC: There are granulomas with giant cells and caseation, with focal ulceration of the mucosa of a bronchus.
