DIAGNOSIS: LUNG - METASTATIC FIBROSARCOMA.

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/33. A lump appeared in the back of the neck at the level of C2. It was removed and shown to be a fibrosarcoma. Two years later metastases were found in the lung and peritoneal cavity although there had been no recurrence at the original site.

MACROSCOPIC: This segment of lung has been partially cut across and folded open to reveal pale well demarcated firm metastases in which small chalky foci of necrosis are seen.

MICROSCOPIC: The neoplasm is made up to whorls and fascicles of spindle cells. In some areas many mitoses were present with only a little interstitial collagen, whilst in others fibrosis was much more obvious.
