DIAGNOSIS: SKULL - HYPEROSTOSIS FRONTALIS INTERNA.

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/76. The lesion was found incidentally at post mortem in an elderly female dying of bronchopneumonia.

MACROSCOPIC: The frontal bones are thickened and on the internal aspect are thrown up into redundant osseous folds.

MICROSCOPIC: The trabeculae are made up of normal lamellar bone which are thicker and more crowded than usual. This condition is symptomless and harmless and occurs especially in elderly obese women with hairy chins. The aetiology is unknown.
