DIAGNOSIS: SKELETAL MUSCLE – PLEOMORPHIC SARCOMA.

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/75. For six months the patient noticed a slowly growing lump deep in the triceps muscle. There was no involvement of the underlying bone detected by X-ray. Biopsy of the lesion showed a sarcoma, and amputation was performed.

MACROSCOPIC: The specimen shows a lobulated, pale tumour within the muscle surrounding the upper portion of the humerus.

MICROSCOPIC: Sections show a pleomorphic sarcoma with a variable pattern. Some areas consist of spindle cells (left image) and other areas show markedly pleomorphic cells including tumour giant cells (right image).
